IDENTIFICATION OF SLOW LEARNERS, PROGRAMMES DEVELOPED AND THEIR PROGRESS ASSESSMENT

The students are divided into batches equally and teaching faculties are assigned to monitor their academic & clinical progress. Students are asked to write assignments on completion of a lecture class for a given chapter along with their viva voce and their performance is assessed. After each internal assessment examination, the list of students who score less than 50% is made taking into consideration, the respective incharges opinion as well as HOD to discuss about the students who require extra attention.

SPECIAL PROGRAMMES CONDUCTED FOR SLOW LEARNERS TO ENHANCE THEIR PERFORMANCE IN THE UNIVERSITY EXAMINATIONS


- Interactive classes are taken by staffs with more flow charts, schematic representations, debates and seminars.
- Special attention is also given to students with difficulty in learning by one to one teaching from staffs.
- Peer group teaching: The students who score more than 60% teach the slow learners during break time and in hostels.
- Interns are also assigned to monitor and teach the slow learners in groups of three. This ensures the intern also prepares for his PG entrance examination and students also feel comfortable and get better grasp in one to one teaching.
- The students who encounter further difficulties will be assessed, parents are called for and senior mentors are allotted to counsel them. Psychiatrist helps the students with depression, mobile addiction, habit addiction and relationship issues etc to get relieved of the same to help in better academic performance.

- Further, many students come from rural areas and have difficulties in understanding the subject taught in English with scientific terminologies. The faculty understands and takes the class in Tamil language along with English to enable clarity and easier learning.
- Parent teachers meeting is conducted twice in an academic year and parents of students who underperform are requested to visit additionally to make them aware of their wards difficulties, steps taken and progress made.
