



2.5.3 INFORMATION ON EXAMINATION REFORMS:

Internal Examination Reforms:

- The examination hall is under continuous CCTV surveillance and the video coverage of the examinations is sent to the university along with the examination papers.
- The halls are installed with the latest cameras and high speed internet connections.
- Three internal assessment exams are conducted simulating the university exam pattern.

University Examination Reforms:

- The parent university takes care of all examination reforms.
- Exams are being conducted and recorded with cameras and videos records are submitted to the university on the same day of examinations along with answer papers.
- Assignment topics for students are selected from the question papers of last 10 years and after evaluation assignments by the faculty members self-assessment is done by the students also.
- Only a particular clinical procedure or experiment is usually given for the examination. The clinical and practical examination provides a number of chances for the candidate to express the skills.
- A number of examination stations with specific instructions is provided. This includes clinical procedures, laboratory experiments, spotters etc.
- Evaluation is made objective and structured. The method of objective structured clinical examinations is followed. This will avoid examiner bias because both the examiner and the examinee are given specific instructions on what is to be observed at each station. This assessment provides a platform to assess a graduate for the competencies required for general dental practice.
