SUMMARY

The camp was organized by students of G-batch, CDCRI (Chettinad Dental College and Research Institute) Kelambakkam. An awareness program on oral health and free dental screening camp was conducted in

- SACRED HEART MAT.HR.SEC.SCHOOL, SHOLINGANALLUR

- SACRED HEART GLOBAL SCHOOL, CBSE, SHOLINGANALLUR

Under the supervision of Dr.NAGALAND sir. Dental screening was performed and common oral conditions were dental caries, dental plaque induced gingivitis, dental fluorosis, fractured teeth, partial and complete edentulism, chronic irreversible pulpitis and Oral thrush. Preventive oral health technique was provided by us to all the students, teaching and nonteaching staffs of the school with the help of models, charts, and presentations.

Total number of patients screened= 257 Students — 160 (Sacred Heart Mat.Hr.Sec.School)

— 97 (Sacred Heart Global School, CBSE)

The age group of general population examined was from 15 to 18 years which included male and female.

Many people of the population were diagnosed with dental caries, fractured tooth, dental plaque induced gingivitis, dental fluorosis and mal-alignment. All the Students were given demonstrations on brushing techniques and demonstrations on oral hygiene aids.

On this day , a special event was conducted on account of “**National Doctor’s Day**”. Awareness talks were given by the CRRIs individually to all the students, teachers and non teaching staffs on early diagnosis and prevention of various oral diseases.

The objective of this event is to create awareness of oral health among school children.

The referral slips were given to all the patients after screening, stating the diagnosis and treatment plan. The hospital details were highlighted.
