2. Dr.P. Rajesh, Dean of Dental College discussed the steps taken by the college to stop ragging according to the directive of Dental council of India and Raghavan Committee proposals appointed by the UGC including the online updating of Anti Ragging Undertaking.
3. All the members of the committee were introduced.
4. Anti ragging pamphlets were distributed to fresher's stating the clauses of UGC Regulations on curbing menace of ragging sensitizing them on the same.
5. Students were also appraised on the presence Placards/ flex boards displaying measures of prevention, prohibition and punishment of students indulged in ragging including the clauses and the names and mobile numbers of all Anti ragging committee members at various places in the college campus.
6. The presence of the professional counselor for fresher's and seniors was enlightened.
7. CCTV cameras installed in various locations in the college to monitor any untoward incidents.

8. The presence of Anti ragging squads who keep frequent vigilance and surprise checks in the boy's hostel, girl's hostel and other vulnerable areas of the college were discussed. The presence of a medical officer posted in the hostel between 5:00pm to 8:00am to address student's grievances was also addressed.
9. Student council members also visit hostel in batches to monitor any incidents.
10. A mentoring cell oversees the senior students mentoring fresher's in campus.
11. Any complaints of ragging received, will be enquired and action taken in one week.
12. A complaint box in front of Dean's office and hostel is present for reporting any complaints.
13. The Tamil Nadu Prohibition and Ragging ordinance 96 and guidelines by Hon'ble Supreme court were discussed.
14. The meeting was concluded emphasizing the importance of curbing the menace called anti ragging in all campuses across India.
