Guidelines for Allotment of BDS seats for admission session 2020-21 in Chettinad Dental College & Research Institute.

Chettinad Dental College & Research Institute is a self financing institution affiliated to The Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R Medical University. There are **two categories of seat allotment** namely government self financing quota and management quota.

All seats in Chettinad Dental College & Research Institute are allotted by the **Selection Committee, Directorate of Medical Education, Kilpauk, Chennai, Tamil Nadu only and Not through DGHS, New Delhi.**

So the NEET qualified students are to apply online separately for government self financing quota and management quota counseling through the Selection Committee, Directorate of Medical Education, Chennai, Tamilnadu in the following website only

I. Important information for Government self financing Quota:

Candidates seeking for admission to BDS Course 2020-21 session under government self financing quota in Chettinad Dental College & Research Institute, affiliated to The Tamilnadu Dr.M.G.R Medical University in Tamil Nadu, The online submission of Application form can be accessed at the following official websites: www.tnmedicalselection.org / www.tnhealth.org

In addition to the filled-in online application form, Candidates should also send the Print out of filled in online application form (Hard copy) with necessary enclosures. The cost of application fee is Rs.500/- (Non-refundable) and should be paid online via bank payment portal in the websites. A copy of receipt of payment paid by the candidates should be attached along with their application form. (as per the 2019-20 admission criteria)

Eligibility Criteria for Government self financing Quota

- (a) Candidates should have completed the age of 17 years at the time of admission or should complete that age on or before 31st December of that year.
- (b) Candidates should be a Native of Tamil Nadu.
- (c) Candidates belonging to Native of Tamil Nadu and having studied from Standard VI to Standard XII in schools of Tamil Nadu need not submit their "Nativity Certificate". However, such candidates should produce the true copies of their parent's certificates such as Birth Certificate, Ration Card SSLC/10th/ 12th/ Degree/Diploma/ Professional course. In case, parents are not literate, then No Graduation Certificate for parents, from the Revenue Authority of competent jurisdiction, to substantiate their parent's place of birth in Tamil Nadu and also "Parent's Community Certificate to claim the communal reservation". If the candidates do not submit the above mentioned certificates, then the candidates will be considered under Open Category only.
- (c) Candidates belonging to other States who are residing at Tamil Nadu cannot claim nativity of Tamil Nadu and they will be considered under Open Category.
- (d) The other State candidates who are not native of Tamil Nadu and have studied from Standard VI to XII in Tamil Nadu will be considered under Open Category

II. Important information for Management Quota:

Candidates seeking for admission to BDS Course 2020-21 session under Management quota in Chettinad Dental College & Research Institute affiliated to The Tamilnadu Dr.M.G.R Medical University in Tamil Nadu, The online submission of Application form can be accessed at the following official websites: www.tnmedicalselection.org / www.tnhealth.org

In addition to the filled-in online application form, Candidates should also send the Print out of filled in online application form (Hard copy) with necessary enclosures. The cost of application fee is Rs.1000/- (Non-refundable) and should be paid online via bank payment portal in the websites. A copy of receipt of payment paid by the candidates should be attached along with their application form. (as per the 2019-20 admission criteria)

Eligibility Criteria for Management Quota

- (a) The NEET qualified Candidates should be a Citizen of India and Candidates should have completed the age of 17 years at the time of admission or should complete that age on or before 31st December of that year.or NRI's as per the prospectors of Selection Committee, Directorate of Medical Education, Chennai, Tamil Nadu guidelines.
