#### SUMMARY:

According to Census 2011 information the location code or village code of Agaram village is 629438. Agaram village is located in Chengalpattu Tehsil of Kancheepuram district in Tamil Nadu, India. Kancheepuram and Chengalpattu are the district & sub-district headquarters of Agaram village respectively. As per 2009 stats, Nellikupam is the gram panchayat of Agaram village.

Multispeciality Medical Camp was conducted by Chettinad academy of research and education in agaram village on 4.9. 2021. We screened nearly 40 patients of which 4 are males, 34 are females. Most of the population screened were geriatric and had difficulty in mastication. Out of the 40 patients screened, 6 were partially edentulous, 3 had dental caries, 18 of them hadgenerised periodontitis, 7 of



them had generalized gingivitis, 4 of them had habit of tobacco chewing and 3 of them had chronic irreversible pulpitis. We screened for nearly 34 hours and medications were given for patients. Patients were guided to have treatment in chettinad dental college and research institute. Health education was given to patients with typho model about method, frequency of brushing and its significance.




#### **SUMMARY:**

A total of 19 patients, comprising of 2 paediatric patients, 14 adult patients and 3 volunteers were screened for commonly seen oral conditions such as edentulism, gingivitis, periodontitis, dental caries and non-carious lesions. Dental caries was the most seen oral condition among the patients. Treatment modalities and consequences of postponing the same were discussed. According to the oral conditions seen, customised health education was provided to the patients, covering the fields of: Oral hygiene aids, influence of oral health on systemic health, the importance of nutrition in the overall well-being of an individual. The role of fluorides in toothpastes was explained to those who resorted to the use of ayurvedic counterparts. Given the number of women residents, the importance of menstrual hygiene and consumption of iron rich food was emphasized upon. #### **CAMP SUMMARY:**

Multispeciality Camp was conducted by Chettinad Academy of Research and Education at Vadakadambadi, Mahabalipuram on 20.12.2021. We screened 31 patients with various dental complaints and had given them appropriate treatment plan and gave referral to our department at the Chettinad Dental College & Research Institute with the screened OP sheet and the Rural Health Centre at Poonjeri. Patient with symptomatic complaints were prescribed medications. Oral Hygiene instructions was given to all the patients generally and specific to their history. Patients with increased Casual Blood Glucose value and Increased Blood Pressure that was screened at the camp were also advised on taking appropriate treatment for glycemic and Blood Pressure control before attending dental treatments and its relationship was explained with pictures after which they were referred for the general medicine screening. Pediatric patients were taught brushing techniques and dietary sugar control counselling was given to them and their guardians/parents. Tobacco chewers were given awareness about the ill-effects of continuing the habit both to their body and oral cavity and given counselling and referred to our Tobacco Cessation Centre at our department. Special cases screened were Early Childhood Caries, Anemic glossitis, Healing Alveolar osteitis for which symptomatic treatment was advised and their implications on the patient's oral hygiene maintenance status was explained. **CENSUS:**





#### WHAT WE LEARNT:


